

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES FOR THE BOROUGH OF MILLTOWN  
POLICE DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREOF FOR  
THE YEARS 2017, 2018 AND 2019**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Milltown, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the following salaries and wages shall be paid to the various officials and employees of the Borough of Milltown Police Department as are hereinafter specified, to take effect January 1, 2017:

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective upon final publication as required by law.




